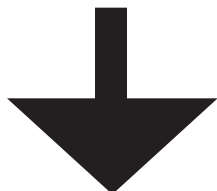

- Has a medical emergency
-or-
- Is in the process of attempting suicide

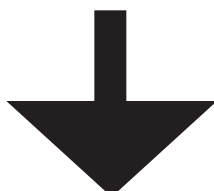

- If a student is exhibiting Verbal or Behavioral signs of serious emotional distress

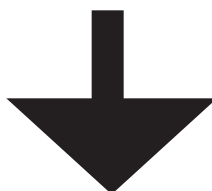

Protocol for Student Crisis Intervention

Follow up: Faculty and staff should also report any crisis to their immediate supervisor as soon as possible. When Security is involved in a Crisis Intervention, an incident report will be filed and a copy of the incident form will be forwarded to the appropriate office area for follow-up.

Reporting Abuse of a Vulnerable Population IS MANDATORY

If you are given information that a child, elder, or person with a disability is being abused you are required by law to report the abuse.

- If person is
- a child, call**Department of Social Services, Law: 978-557-2500, or Hav: 978-469-8800
 - an elder, call**the 24 hour hotline to report elder abuse: 800-922-2275
 - disabled, call**the Disabled Persons Protection Commission 800-426-9009 V/TTY
