SAT Scores to be used as Waiver

Student presents a copy of his/her SAT scores to <u>Enrollment Services</u> or <u>Grace</u> Young in the Advising Center. They enter waivers (*APTC does not enter waivers*).

If the student arrives first in Assessment, copy the scores and then explain that he/she must also bring the scores to Enrollment Services or to the Advising Center so that they can enter the official waivers. Inform the student that the placement cannot be put in the system until the waiver is entered.

Review student's scores and test accordingly:

SAT CRITICAL READING - Old SAT scores

- Verbal SAT 500 plus waives student from reading assessment
- Verbal SAT 600 plus waives student from both reading and writing assessment.

SAT READING TEST – New SAT scores

- SAT 27 plus waives student from reading assessment
- SAT 32 plus waives student from both reading and writing assessment.

**There are no math SAT waivers. Students MUST assess for math.
